



Streamline Aquatics Code of Conduct for Coaches

- Adhere to USA Swimming's rules and code of conduct at all times.
- Set a positive example of respect and sportsmanship for participants and fans.
- Act and dress with professionalism and dignity, suitable to the coaching profession.
- Respect officials and their judgment, abiding by the rules of the event.
- Treat opposing coaches, participants, and spectators with respect.
- Instruct participants in sportsmanship and demand they display good sportsmanship.
- Coach in a positive manner, avoiding derogatory comments or abusive language.
- Win with humility and lose with dignity.
- Treat every athlete fairly, justly, impartially, intelligently, and with sensitivity.
- Always prioritize the well-being, health, and safety of swimmers above all other considerations, including performance development.
- Continually seek and maintain professional development in all areas related to coaching and teaching children.
- Maintain a professional separation between coach and athlete at all times.
